Common Grounds Café Update...

We have been heavy into cleaning at the café, washing walls, scrubbing floors and several repairs and updates. Repairs have included plumbing, lighting, and some equipment repairs. We have also received generous donations from the Cass City Chamber of Commerce and other individuals. These financial donations made the way for the much needed ceiling tiles. We also received equipment donations, an 8 burner commercial range/oven, convection oven, and soup warmers . We are in the middle of updating the front of the café with some new drywall, lighting, and flooring. The old counter was removed to open up more space for extra seating. Soon the exterior updates will begin. We are currently awaiting the Health Department inspection. It consist of the transfer of ownership and a discussion as to the direction Revive would like to go with the café. Our remodel/update project estimated cost is approximately \$55,000. With the financial and equipment donations and Revive we currently are in short fall of approximately \$30,000. We are in the process of grant writing for some of the cost. The big ticket item is the suppression hood. As you can see we do have some prayer and financial needs. Please consider what avenue God is leading you to. We would love to have you be a part of the ministry!
